Selection of Recipients

Students are selected based on academic performance and demonstrated financial need. The criteria for selection include the following:

- Parents are required to submit a "Student Aid Application" to the Private School Aid Service to assess need.
- Students should have and maintain a B academic average, possess a positive attitude and maintain a respectable behavior record.
- For incoming freshman, a recommendation from his/her elementary school principal is required.

Donors

Donors are asked to make a four-year pledge and if possible to fund up to 50% of a student's annual tuition. Your gift to sponsor a student is tax-deductible and can be made quarterly, semi-

annually, or annually. The donor may remain anonymous or share personally in the student's progress and achievement.
